



Northwest Flyers Scholarship Fund Track and Field Season

Dear Athlete and Parents:

The Northwest Flyers Track Club Scholarship Committee is pleased to again offer scholarship awards from our College Scholarship Fund. Each year, the committee may award one, several or no scholarships. The scholarship competition is open to all Northwest Flyer athletes meeting the eligibility requirements and submitting their completed College Scholarship application May 1st. The maximum scholarship amount is \$1000.00 and may be renewed for your second year in college.

Applicants must meet the following requirements for eligibility;

- Member in good standing of the NW Flyers Track Club for minimum of 3 years.
- Competed in at least one “Association” X-C or Track & Field Championship (USATF).
- Graduate from high school with a diploma recognized by the State of Texas.
- Achieve minimum high school cumulative GPA of 3.3 (out of 4.0) through mid-point of senior year.
- Must be accepted and enrolled in a full-time* course of study at an accredited two-year or four year college or university.
- Provide at least one letter of recommendation attesting to the athlete’s character and leadership (i.e. at school, church, in the community).

** Full-time study is defined as full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year.*

Bonus points for additional consideration (max 4 stars)

- NW Flyers Track Club member during senior year in high school.
- Competed in at least one US Junior Olympics Championship (X-C or Track & Field).
- Earned varsity letter in high school (X-C or Track & Field).
- Plans to compete at the college level (X-C or Track & Field).

Important Dates:

March 1 Applications are available from website and pickup
May 1 Completed applications must be returned to the awards committee
June 1 Final selections made and award winners are notified
Fall Scholarships paid directly to the athlete's college or university

Our Scholarship awards come from the "Scholarship Fund" and not general club revenue. Please see our website for additional information. Contact Director Pal Roach or Dr. Kerry Kirkman (scholarship chairperson) with any questions you may have.
